The theme for Animal Health Investment Europe in year five is 'change'. To what extent has the animal health industry changed in the past five years?

The animal health industry continues to change rapidly with an increasing number of megatrends and rising consumer challenges. Most recently, there have been two significant developments in the animal health industry. First, many companies are now consolidating their businesses within a few top-tier animal health companies, which has dramatically changed the landscape of the industry. Second, animal health companies are extending beyond their medicines, vaccines and health management solutions and services into related areas of diagnostics, technology, nutritional and even genetic spaces. This change I expect will continue to reshape animal health over the next five years, and is a topic that we will be exploring at Animal Health Investment Europe in London.

We had close to 200 innovators present at the forum. What is the MSD Animal Health approach to external innovation?
