



Q&A WITH DUAL GROUP

CAN YOU SHARE ANY GROUND-BREAKING PROJECTS THAT YOU HAVE PREVIOUSLY BEEN INVOLVED IN?

I think due to the nature of the organisations I've worked in, ground breaking might be a little bit of a stretch as they are by their very nature established and consistent, which is what you need in the Financial and Insurance industries. The introduction of GDPR has probably been one of the biggest and most key changes I've been involved in. I was a part of both steering and working groups for GDPR, at that time Data Governance wasn't as well known and prior to GDPR, Data Privacy could be seen as something a bespoke set of experts looked after. I think what has definitely changed and can be seen as ground breaking is the sharing of responsibility for these genres, across organisations with guidance and support being given by the experts.

WHAT ARE THE MOST EXCITING DATA GOVERNANCE ADVANCEMENTS THAT HAVE EMERGED IN THE PAST COUPLE OF YEARS, AND WHY?

I find the fact that Data Governance is becoming more well-known and understood is exciting in itself. Technological advancements are continually adapting, what is still hard to find is a complete and affordable set of technology for Data Governance which can be on boarded without a complete overhaul of existing technology.
